- 1963 Ohio Department of Natural Resources Dam Safety program initiated
- 1969 Several Ohio dam failures led to revised law requiring periodic dam inspections
- 1972 Buffalo Creek Dam, WV fails 125 dead
- 1972 National Dam Inspection Act
- 1970s Knox Cattle Dam regulation began in mid-1970s per Mayor Mavis' August 5, 2019 letter to Landings Property Owners
- 1976 Teton Dam, ID fails 14 dead
- 1977 Kelly Barnes Dam, GA fails 39 dead
- 1980s Various acts passed and programs initiated
- 1983 Association of Dam Safety Organizations forms
- 1996 National Dam Safety Act
- 1998 FEMA launches Model Dam Safety Program
